GATE POINTS TO BE AWARDED TO SHOW JUMPING CLASSES ONLY

Classes within this schedule are open to all, however only exhibitors that meet qualification criteria will qualify.

Qualifier for Equifest This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground on the 09th –13th August 2017. The **two** highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (CHAPS UK) Reference 17059

- "This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No. 17059
- Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card IN THE RING for signing by the judge.
- Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card.
- The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 31st August-2nd September 2017. Shows held on or after the Championship Show will count as 2018 qualifiers.
- The following classes are CHAPS (UK) Qualifiers 2A,3A,4A,36,37. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com for rulings.
- All stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). All stallions must wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception.

TOYS Show (TGCA affiliation number TGCA/04/17/007)

These classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Top three in each class qualify. In open height classes, top three in small and large sections qualify. Stallions - All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST have their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Existing TGCA members must present their qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non members will receive a qualification card from the judge and will have 21 days to join the TGCA and to register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to www.tgca.co.uk for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members handbook).

TSR Riders & IN HAND Championships - This show is a qualifier for the 2017 TSR Riders/In Hand Regional Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Regional Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Champs - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Champs - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

fences not to exceed 30cm (1ft) – ponies not to exceed 133cm (6 jumps)

Class 2 **Cradle Stakes** - Fences not to exceed 40cm (1ft 3") Riders 12 and
under 01.01.17(6 Jumps)

Class 3 **Mini Jumping and Assisted Jumping** Riders to be 12 years and under
01.01.2017 Fences not to exceed 45cm (1ft 6") – ponies not to exceed
138cm (6 Jumps)

Class 4 **Very Novice Jumping** – Fences not to exceed 45cm (1ft 6")- This is for
Novice Horse or Rider (8 jumps)

NOT BEFORE 11AM

Competitors **CANNOT** continue in the 2nd phase if faults are occurred in the 1st
phase if more than 10 competitors in the class

**Class 5-10 - 2 phase 6 jumps in first phase, if clear then complete another 4
jumps against the clock**

Open to Horses and Ponies Riders any age. First round clears will carry straight on into
a timed jump off. The first round will be timed for further placings – the least faults in the
fastest round. Ponies classed as up to 148cm. Please specify whether your entry is for
the horse or pony section.

Class 7 **Starter Stakes**- Not To Exceed 60cm (1ft 9" to 2ft) – 2 phase jumping

Class 8 **Training Stakes** – Not To Exceed 70 cm (2ft 3) – 2 phase Jumping

Class 14 **Novice Open** – Not to Exceed 90cm (3ft) – 2 phase Jumping

All in hand classes are TSR Qualifiers you must have your card beforehand and get it signed in the ring

Class 1 – In hand open best turned out – to be judged on overall presentation

Class 3A– CHAPS UK In Hand Non Native Type 4 years and over (EF,CHAPS UK) Non-Native Open In-Hand Qualifier, any height any age

Class 4A- Chaps UK In Hand Native Cob and Traditional Type 4 years and over (EF,CHAPS UK). Native/Cob/Traditional Open In-Hand Qualifier, any height any age

Class 5 A- In Hand Open Traditional Gypsy Cob Association (TGCA) . Young stock 3 years and under

Class 6 A- In Hand Open Traditional Gypsy Cob Association (TGCA) . 4 years and older

Championship for Classes 2A – 6A

Class 7 – **In Hand Adult Handler Class** – for competitors over 16 years on the 01/01/2017

Class 8 – **In Hand Newcomer Class** – If you are new to showing and want to have a go the judge will give you guidance on how you could perhaps improve next time. Special Rosettes to be awarded

Class 9– **Young Handler** 16 years and under on 01/01/2017 . Safety head gear and gloves must be worn. Special rosette given to the highest placed 11yr old and under, arm bands must be worn as identification for this award

Championship for Classes 1,7,8 & 9 (1st and 2nd Prize winners)

Class 10 - **In Hand open M & M** (EF). Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland horses and ponies – all welcome however to obtain Qualification you must be registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. any age

Class 11- **In Hand Riding Pony or Family pony** (EF) . In hand Riding Ponies, stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Any age. All welcome however only competitors that comply with EF rules will qualify

Class 12- **Open In Hand Youngstock** . 3 years old and under

Class 13– **In Hand Show Type, Hack, Hunter, Riding Horse and Show Cob** any age class may be split if entries warrant

Class 14 – **Open In Hand Veteran 15 Years & over.** (TSR) Open to horses and ponies over the age of 15

Class 15 –**In Hand Open Class** . Open to all other horses and ponies of any age and breed.

Class 16 - **In Hand Pure Bred Arabs, Part Breds & Anglo Arabs**– classes may be split if entries warrant

Class 17– **In Hand Shetland and Miniature Horses** (TSR). ponies any age

Class 18 - **In Hand Race Horse to Riding Horse** (TSR)– old racing injuries will be overlooked

Championship for Classes 10-18 (1st and 2nd Prize winners)

Class 24 Ridden best turned out – to be judged on presentation

Class 25 Lead Rein M&M, Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony. (EF, TSR) Open to all only competitors that are within the guidelines will qualify

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

Show Pony - Leading Rein Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

Show Hunter Pony – Lead Rein, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Rider not to have attained their 9th Birthday before 1st January in the current year

Class 26 –First Ridden M&M, Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony .(EF,TSR) Open to all only competitors that are within the guidelines will qualify

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Show Pony - First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Show Hunter Pony - First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

Class 27 Open Ridden M&M (EF, TSR, EL) and Junior Ridden M & M (EF, TSR,) Open to all; only competitors that are within the guidelines will qualify

Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over.

Extra Qualification will be given to highest placed Junior Ridden M & M Riders of Small Breeds not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. And Riders of Large Breeds not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year

Championship for Classes 25 - 27

Class 28 Newcomer Class *Special rosettes to be awarded – For competitors new to showing. Guidance will be given by the judge on what to do and how you could perhaps improve next time – come and have a go at showing (Snaffle Bridle)*

Class 29 Very novice Horse or Pony – *walk and trot only, canter optional in individual show – to be judged on the nature it is intended – Best Novice Horse or Pony (Snaffle Bridle)*

Class 30 Very Novice Rider – *walk and trot only, canter optional in individual show – to be judged on the nature it is intended – Best Novice Rider*

Class 31 Lead Rein Best Rider – *up to 8yrs old - as of 01.01.17*

Class 32 Junior Best Rider – *up to 16yrs as of 01/01/2017 – to walk and trot together only canter in Individual show. 40% rider position and effectiveness of aids, 40% individual show, 20% overall presentation*

Class 33 Senior Best Rider – *17yrs old and over on 01/01/2017*

Class 34 New combination for 2017 – *Horse and Rider to be a new combination for the 2017 season*

Class 35 – Open Ridden Class *Open to any type, foreign breeds inc – Judged on way of going/show*

Equifest - The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship. Subject to their show rules & conditions

Class 36 - **CHAPS (UK) Non-Native Open Ridden Qualifier, (Chaps Uk, TSR, EF,)**

Any height, 4 yrs and over to be shown plaited and trimmed

Class 37 **CHAPS (UK) Native/Cob/Traditional Open Ridden Qualifier (Chaps Uk, TSR, EF,)**

Any height. 4 yrs and over

Class 38 - **TRADITIONAL GYPSY COB QUALIFIER (TGCA)**

Open ridden 4 years old and over

CHAMPIONSHIP FOR CLASSES 36 -38 (*1st and 2nd Prize winners*)

Class 39 - **Ridden Show Type, Show Hunter, Hack and Riding Horse (EF,TSR,) open to all only competitors that comply with guidelines will qualify**

Open Show Hacks, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms. Riders any age.

Open Riding Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Riders any age.

Open Small Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age.

Class 40 - **Ridden Cob (EF,TSR,) open to all only competitors that comply with guidelines will qualify-** Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cm but not exceeding 155cms. Riders any age. Open Maxi Cobs, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 155cms to be judged as Cobs

Class 41 - **Ridden Show Pony, Show Hunter Pony, ISRT, ISHT (EF,TSR,) open to all; only competitors that comply with guidelines will qualify**

Open Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Open Intermediate Show Riding Type, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Open Intermediate Show Hunter Type, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Show Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Class 42 – **Open Ridden Veteran (TSR)** Ridden 15 Years & over. Open to horses and ponies over the age of 15

Class 43 – **Ridden Pure/ Part Bred Arabs and foreign breeds (TSR,EF,)**

Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exhibits in this section must be registered in the Part Bred section of their respective Breed Society. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form. Horses and ponies will not be ridden at the final. Riders any age.

Class 44 – **Racehorse to Riding Horse (TSR)** to be judged on overall appearance and show – racing injuries will be overlooked

Championship for Classes 39 – 44 (*1st and 2nd Prize winners*)

SHOW GROUND RULES

RULES & CONDITIONS

British riding Club Rules Apply

The Gate Inn Riding Club and / or the organising committee cannot be held responsible for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, ponies, riders, owners, grooms, ground spectators or any other person or property whatsoever other than the liability for a refund of entry fee in the event of abandonment of the competition.

HEALTH & SAFETY

The organisers of this event have taken all responsible precautions to ensure Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all responsible precautions to avoid accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and stewards.

SHOW SAFETY

- 1 All persons on the showground must comply with the safety advice and directions given by Club officials and displayed on safety notices
- 2 All riders when riding, whether competing or not, must wear hard hats that are up to UK current standards with a strap properly adjusted and fastened insurance will be void if standards are not met. See BRC Hat Guidelines
- 3 Appropriate protective clothing, including footwear must be worn by all persons on the showground when mounted or handling a horse
- 4 Entries accepted at rider's risk.
- 5 The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry at their discretion, cancel, amend or amalgamate any class for any reason whatsoever.
- 6 The organiser's/Judges decision is final.
- 7 Only riders entered to compete in the show may use the practice ring and must jump the practice fence in the direction indicated with the red wing on the right hand wing. When jumping a practice fence the height of the fence must be within accordance with the height of the fences in the ring at the time. Grooms and owners are not eligible to use this facility.
- 8 A fall of the rider will result in elimination from the competition. Such dismounted riders should not remount whilst in the ring or dressage arena.
- 9 Competitors should be mounted on suitably sized ponies or horses. Should a judge or show official be concerned that a rider is under or over-horsed they will be requested to withdraw in the interests of safety or animal cruelty
- 10 Stallion and Colts must be correctly bitted and handlers to be over 16 years of age.
- 11 Any Objections or complaints must be made to the secretary in writing with a £20.00 Deposit within 30 minutes of the incident happening
- 12 Show jumping Classes will be judged under BSJA rules with exception of the GRC Rules
- 12 Dogs Must be on a lead
- 13 All annual Trophies must be returned in clean condition no later than the last show of the season

At the next roundabout, take the **3rd** exit onto **Coton Rd**

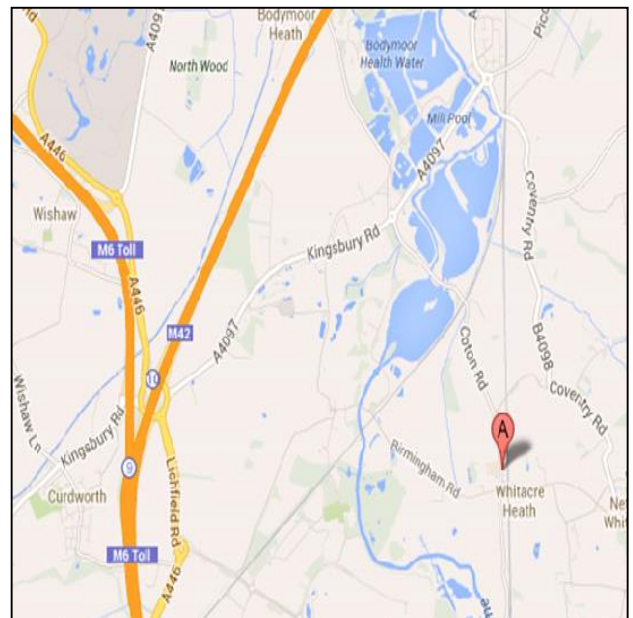
Turn left onto Halloughton Grange and immediately right
