RING ONE SHOW JUMPING 930am Start

Members £4.00 per class Non Members £6.00

Classes 1-5 Will be one round - Placings will be the least faults in the fastest time

Rosettes - 1-6 place

- Class 1** **Lead Rein Jumping** 12 yrs. and under on 01.01.2018
fences not to exceed 30cm (1ft) – ponies not to exceed 138cm (6 jumps) ponies must be on a lead rein attached to the nose band
- Class 2** **Assisted Tiny Tots** 12 yrs. and under on 01.01.2018
fences not to exceed 30cm (1ft) – ponies not to exceed 138cm (6 jumps) – support can be given in the ring to riders
- Class 3** **Cradle Stakes** - Fences not to exceed 40cm (1ft 3") Riders 13 and under 01.01.18 (6 Jumps) ponies not to exceed 138cm
- Class 4** **Mini Jumping** Riders to be 13 years and under 01.01.2018 Fences not to exceed 45cm (1ft 6") – ponies not to exceed 138cm (6 Jumps)
- Class 5** **Very Novice Jumping** – Fences not to exceed 45cm (1ft 6") - This is for **Novice** pony/Horse or Rider (8 jumps)

NOT BEFORE 11.00AM

Competitors are not to continue in the 2nd phase if faults are occurred in the 1st phase if more than 5 competitors in the class

Class 6-11 - 2 phase 6 jumps in first phase, if you go clear then complete another 4 jumps against the clock

Open to Horses and Ponies Riders any age. First round clears will carry straight on into a timed jump off. The first round will be timed for further placings – the least faults in the fastest round. Ponies classed as up to 148cm. Please specify whether your entry is for the horse or pony section.

NO FILLERS IN CLASS 6 – 9

- Class 6** **Warm Up Stakes-** Not To Exceed 55cm (1ft 6" to 1ft 9") – 2 phase jumping
- Class 7** **Starter Stakes-** Not To Exceed 60cm (1ft 9" to 2ft) – 2 phase jumping
- Class 8** **Nursery Stakes** Not To Exceed 65cm (2ft) – 2 phase jumping
- Class 9** **Training Stakes** – Not To Exceed 70 cm (2ft 3) – 2 phase Jumping

FILLERS WILL BE ADDED IN FROM CLASS 10

Not Before 1pm

- Class 10** **Pre Novice** -Not To Exceed 70cm (2ft to 2ft 3") – 2 phase jumping
- Class 11** **Novice Stakes-** Not To Exceed 75 cm (2ft 3" to 2ft 6") – 2 phase jumping

Classes 12 – 14 = 2 phase jumping to consist of 8 jumps in first phase and 4 jumps in second phase

- Class 12** **Newcomer Stakes** open to Horse and Ponies, Height of jumps will not Exceed 80 cm
- Class 13** **Intermediate-** Not To Exceed 85cm (2ft 6" to 2ft 9") – 2 phase jumping
- Class 14** **Novice Open** – Not to Exceed 90cm (3ft) – 2 phase Jumping

- Fun Class A Handy Pony** – Horse/Pony and Rider to complete a course of different obstacles
- Class 15 Open In Hand Best Turned Out** 40% horse, 40% handler, 20% overall presentation
- Class 16 In Hand Novice Handler** – please compete in this class if you are a novice handler – new to showing 20% overall appearance, 60% efficiency of handling, 20% ring craft
- Class 17 In Hand Family/riding club horse or pony** -40% Manners 40% suitability 20% Conformation
- Class 18 In Hand Adult Class** for competitors over 16 years of age on the 01.01.2018 20% overall appearance, 60% efficiency of handling, 20% ring craft
- Class 19 New combination for 2018** – Horse and Rider to be a new combination for the 2018 season to be judged 50% individual show 20% overall presentation 30% suitability
- Class 20 In Hand Young Handler** –Safety head gear and gloves must be worn – 16yr and under on 01.01.18 30% overall appearance, 50% efficiency of handling, 20% ring craft. Special rosette given to the highest placed 12yr old and under, arm bands must be worn as identification.

Breed and Type Classes - Entry Fee Members £4.00 Non Members £6.00

- Class 24 Open In Hand Class** – open to all horses and ponies of any age or breed 40% conformation, 30% way of going, 30% manners. Will be split horses and ponies if entries warrant.
- Class 25 In Hand Young Stock (3yrs and under)** 40% conformation, 30% manners/way of going, 30% overall impression
- Class 26 In Hand Pure Bred Arabs, Part Breds & Anglo Arabs and Foreign Breeds**– 30% manners 40% way of going 30% Conformation classes may be split
- Class 27 In Hand Coloured, Cremello, Dun, Roan, Spotted, Palomino** – open to all horses and ponies of any age 40% conformation, 30% way of going, 30% manners.
- Class 28 In Hand Mountain and Moorland** 60% correctness of breed type, 20% manners, 20% overall presentation
- Class 29 In Hand Show Hack/Show Pony and Show hunter Horse/Pony** – any show horse/pony type to include Racehorse 40% Conformation 30% Manners 30% overall presentation
- Class 30 In Hand Traditional Gypsy Cob, Shire, Heavy or Driving type** 40% conformation, 40% manners and individual show, 20% overall presentation
- Class 31 In Hand Shetland and Miniatures** 30% Manners, 40% conformation 30% overall presentation
- Class 32 In Hand Veteran** - Horses and ponies over 15yrs 50% condition, 25% conformation, 25% way of going. Class may be split if entries warrant 15yr-20yrs and over 20yrs

- Class 33** **Open Ridden Best Turned Out** – 40% horse, 30% rider, 30% overall presentation - to just walk round.
- Class 34** **The Endeavour Class** - Not to go round with other horses / ponies - To perform a show of what you feel comfortable and happy with doing on the day (even if it's just a walk round) any age, lead rein welcome this is class for genuine Nervous or True Novice competitors
- Class 35** **Lead Rein Best Rider** – up to 10yrs old - as of 01.01.18 Classes to be judged 40% rider position and effectiveness of aids, 40% individual show, 20% overall presentation
- Class 36** **Very Novice Horse or Pony** – walk and trot only, canter optional in individual show – to be judged on the nature it is intended – Best Novice Horse or Pony (Snaffle Bridle)
- Class 37** **Very Novice Rider** – walk and trot only, canter optional in individual show – to be judged on the nature it is intended – Best Novice Rider
- Class 38** **First Ridden Best Rider** – up to 12yrs as of 01/01/2018 – ponies not to exceed 138cm to walk and trot together only canter in Individual show. 40% rider position and effectiveness of aids, 40% individual show, 20% overall presentation
- Class 39** **Open Best Rider** – 12 years old and over on 01/01/2018 40% rider position and effectiveness of aids, 40% individual show, 20% overall presentation classes will be split if entries warrant (18 and over)
- Class 40** **New combination for 2018** – Horse and Rider to be a new combination for the 2018 season to be judged 50% individual show 20% overall presentation 30% suitability

CHAMPIONSHIP FOR RIDDEN CLASS FOR CLASSES 33-40 (1st and 2nd Prize winners)

Not Before 12 00 pm

- Class 41** **Ridden & L/R Mountain and Moorland** – open to any native breed including Shetlands 50% correctness of type, 30% manners & individual show, 20% overall presentation. Lead Rein welcome – separate points for L/R – class may be split
- Class 42** **Ridden Coloured, Cremello, Palomino, Dun, Roan and Spotted Open** – 40% conformation, 30% way of going, 30% manners – class may be split
- Class 43** **Ridden Show Hack/Show Pony and Show hunter Horse/Pony** Type Any bridle 30% conformation, 45% individual show, 25% overall impression
- Class 44** **Ridden Cob, Hunter and Riding Horse Type Horse or Pony – any cob types** - Any bridle 30% conformation, 45% individual show, 25% overall impression
- Class 45** **Working Show Type Horse Or Pony** – To jump 3 fences at a height to suit competitors on the day then perform a short show for the judge Overall Impression 20%, Conformation 40% Way of Going 40%
- Class 46** **Open Riding Club or Family Horse or Pony** – snaffle bridle, no martingale 30% manners, 40% individual show, 30% suitability – optional Cross pole to be jumped
- Class 47** **Open Ridden Class** – open to all horses and ponies any breed inc Racehorses (Award to highest placed ROR) 40% conformation, 30% way of going, 30% manners. Will be split - horses and ponies if entries warrant.
- Class 48** **Ridden Traditional Gypsy Cob, heavy, Shire or Driving Type** – 50% correctness of type, 30% manners and individual show, 20% overall presentation
- Class 49** **Ridden Veteran Horse or Pony** horse or pony over 15yrs old 15-20yrs and 20yrs + 40% condition, 20% conformation, 40% individual show – class may be split if entries warrant . L/R Welcome
- Class 50** **Pure Bred Arab/ Part bred Arabs/Anglo Arabs or Foreign Breeds** 30% manners 40% Individual show, 30% Conformation

CHAMPIONSHIP FOR RIDEN CLASSES 41 -50 (1st and 2nd Prize winners)

RULES & CONDITIONS British Riding Club Rules Apply

The Gate Riding Club and / or the organising committee cannot be held responsible for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, ponies, riders, owners, grooms, ground spectators or any other person or property whatsoever other than the liability for a refund of entry fee in the event of abandonment of the competition.

The organisers of this event have taken all responsible precautions to ensure Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all responsible precautions to avoid accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and stewards.

- 1 All persons on the showground must comply with the safety advice and directions given by Club officials and displayed on safety notices
- 2 All riders when riding, whether competing or not, must wear hard hats that are up to UK current standards with a strap properly adjusted and fastened. Insurance will be void if standards are not met. See BRC Hat Guidelines for compliance
- 3 Appropriate protective clothing, including footwear must be worn by all persons on the showground when mounted or handling a horse
- 4 Entries accepted at rider's risk.
- 5 The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry at their discretion, cancel, amend or amalgamate any class for any reason whatsoever.
- 6 The organiser's/Judges decision is final.
- 7 Only riders entered to compete in the show may use the practice ring and must jump the practice fence in the direction indicated with the red wing on the right hand wing. When jumping a practice fence the height of the fence must be within accordance with the height of the fences in the ring at the time. Grooms and owners are not eligible to use this facility.
- 8 A fall of the rider will result in elimination from the class. Such dismounted riders should not remount whilst in the ring or dressage arena.
- 9 Competitors should be mounted on suitably sized ponies or horses. Should a judge or show official be concerned that a rider is under or over-horsed they will be requested to withdraw in the interests of safety or animal cruelty
- 10 Stallion and Colts must be correctly bitted and handlers to be over 16 years of age.
- 11 Any Objections or complaints must be made to the secretary in writing with a £20.00 Deposit within 30 minutes of the incident happening
- 12 Show jumping Classes will be judged under BS rules with exception of the Gate Riding Club Rules
- 12 Dogs must be on a lead at all times
- 13 All annual Trophies must be returned in clean condition no later than the last show of the season
- 14 competitors are to have their own third party liability insurance

From the M42 Junction 9, take the exit onto **Kingsbury Rd/A4097**

At the next roundabout, take the **3rd** exit onto **Coton Rd** .

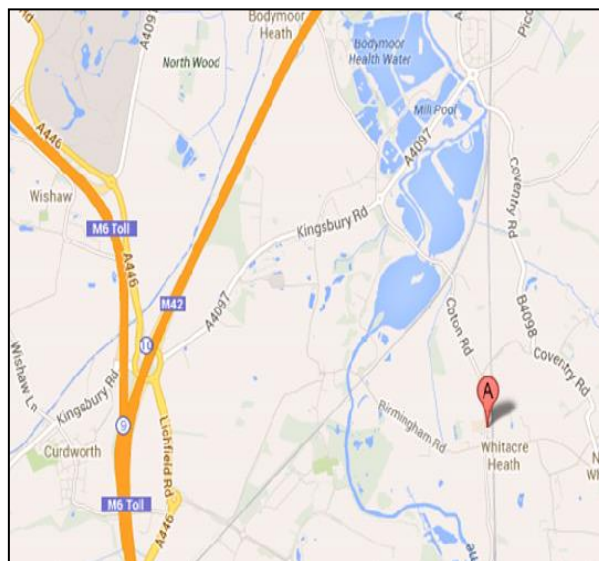
Turn left onto Halloughton Grange and immediately right
